

HAND HELD Hot Knife

APPLICATION:

This hot knife is perfect for cutting all types of synthetic ropes and is to be used often but not all of the time. It is recommended for short-time operation and low volume. Heat up time is approx. 6-8 seconds. It is suitable for cutting rope up to 18mm diameter. The cutter gives a clean, neat cut that also prevents rope/braid from fraying.



PREPARATION:

- 1. Select a hot knife blade corresponding to the cutting use.
- 2. Loosen the knurled nut when device is cold.
- 3. Insert each leg of the blade and tighten the knurled nuts making sure that the blade and the cutting head have optimal contact.

N.B. IF BOTH LEGS OF THE BLADE ARE NOT PROPERLY INSTALLED, THE UNIT WILL NOT HEAT UP.

CUTTING:

- 1. Switch on, the indicator light and the blade will heat up. Avoid direct short circuit between cutting
- 2. Clean cutting heads with enclosed wire brush.
- 3. Please make sure the blade is connected to the cutting material before blade heats up.

CAUTION:

- 1. Always opperate the hot knife in well ventilated space.
- 2. Never burn off the excess residue on the hot knife blade, The blades will over heat and be warped.
- 3. Keep hot blades away from skin, clothing and other flamable materials.
- 4. Allow blades to cool before handling. Hot knife may cause injury or burns to exposed surfaces.
- 5. If the temperature inside the tool is too high, the unit will get hot and the internal thermal protectors will turn it off, after it cools the knife will operate again.
